Our hosts are Lincoln University Dairy Farm
Shands Road, Lincoln



The 186ha farm acts as a principal research area for sustainable dairying on a commercial scale. It provides a base for science to develop world best practice and to pass on this information to farmers. The property is one of the top performing farms in New Zealand, milking 656 cows, twice a day, on 159 effective hectares of fully irrigated land.

They will host a farm walk based around this dairy operation. Details will be confirmed closer to the day.

We also hope to have other activities relating to farming for people to do, and animals to see and touch.

This is not a 'wander at will' farm tour. The public will be met at the gate, put into groups and escorted around the farm.

We need your help on the day to make FARM DAY a success. Please think about lending a hand. There will be a FARM DAY session for helpers at the farm. Volunteers will be contacted as to the date and time before the day.
